

Discipline: Please review the Caddo Parish School Board discipline policy with your child(ren), located on the parish and school website, www.caddoschools.org. The rights of students to learn in a friendly, orderly, safe learning environment will be protected and valued. Disrespect for adults and other students, violent or obscene behavior by any student will be dealt with severely.

Attendance: The tardy policy and school attendance policy will be strictly enforced and names of habitual violators will be submitted to the CPSB Attendance and Welfare Department.

Cell Phones: Students are not allowed to use cell phones or have them turned on, or visible, from 7:45 A.M. to 3:15 P.M. Those in violation of this rule will have his/her phone taken up and held by the assistant principal for three days. A parent is required to pick up the phone at that time. The only exception to this rule is if a teacher has planned a lesson whereby the use of an electronic device may be used. Please note that if a lesson is planned, **it is not mandatory.**

Promotion Criteria:

Kindergarten:

Students must successfully pass the end of the year reading and math tests with at least a 67%; met attendance requirements.

1st - 5th Grade Students:

Students must successfully pass 2 of the following subjects - reading, language or math **AND** either science or social studies; met attendance requirements and has standardized test scores.

6th - 8th Grade Students:

Students must pass 6 of 7 subjects, one of which must be reading or math; met attendance requirements and has standardized test scores.



DISMISSAL REMINDER:

Please note that during dismissal, if you **double park** on the side streets (parking on both sides) or park along Henry Street, you will be issued a ticket by Shreveport Police.
